Van With Wheelchair Access to be Donated to Army Captain December 9

Event will take place 11:30am at Winning Technologies offices 147 Triad West in O'Fallon, MO

Winning Technologies and Carson Natural Bridge Automotive will be officially donating a Dodge Sport Minivan to a St. Louis-based Captain in the U.S. Army whose son was injured in an automobile accident. The event will take place on 11:30am on Friday, December 9, 2011 at the offices of Winning Technologies, 147 Triad West in O'Fallon, MO.

Captain Chris Nordin's 21-year-old son Jeremie was injured in automobile accident near New Braunfels, TX on July 3, 2011. Jeremie has been unable to walk since the accident. The two businesses are joining forces to provide the Nordins with a van complete with wheelchair access to help with the family's transportation needs.

Scott Lewis, President of Winning Technologies, was contacted by Family Readiness Support regarding Captain Nordin's need for a specially equipped van. Lewis contacted Bill Vance owner of Carson Natural Bridge Automotive who had access to an already modified minivan. The two partnered to repair and ready the vehicle. Nordin has been testing the van since late November. He is stationed at Jefferson Barracks.

"It is the least we can do to assist the families of our soldiers who make such big sacrifices on our behalf, it is a humbling tribute to be able to provide him with something he and his family most certainly need," Lewis said.
